First Annual Order of Zion Mardi Gras Ball

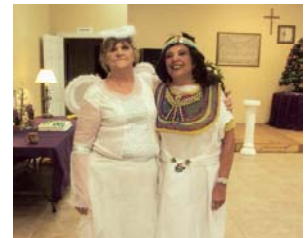

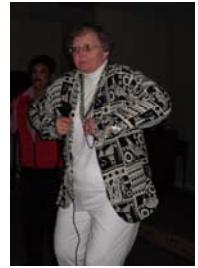


There were folks in costume, folks in plain street clothes, and folks in "formal attire". We just loved seeing Boomer in tails (and jeans)!
